

End User License Agreement (EULA) – b<>com *Open XG Hub* software

IMPORTANT: BY DOWNLOADING, INSTALLING, COPYING, OR USING THE *OPEN XG HUB* SOFTWARE, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA). IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT, DO NOT DOWNLOAD, INSTALL, COPY, OR USE THE SOFTWARE.

This End User License Agreement ("**EULA**") is a legally binding agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity, referred to as "**User**") and FONDATION B-COM (b<>com), headquartered at 1219 avenue des Champs Blancs, (35510) Cesson-Sévigné, France (SIREN 751 468 943) for the use of the *Open XG Hub* software ("**Software**").

1. LICENSE GRANT

b<>com grants User a free of charge, non-exclusive, worldwide, personal, non-transferable, revocable and limited license to use the Software, in binary form, solely for evaluation and research and development purposes.

Any use of the Software not explicitly authorized by the above grant is forbidden. In particular, the User is forbidden from:

- Using the Software for any commercial, revenue-generating, or production purposes;
- Transferring, assigning, sublicensing or lending the Software to any third party;
- Modifying, adapting, translating, creating derivative works of the Software;
- Reverse engineering, decompiling, disassembling or attempting to derive the source code of the Software;
- Removing or altering any copyright or proprietary notice in the Software;
- Using the Software in a manner that violates applicable laws or regulations.

User must use the Software in accordance with its documentation and any technical requirements communicated by b<>com.

User acknowledges and agrees that all intellectual property rights in the Software are and will remain the sole property of b<>com (or its licensors, as applicable).

2. THIRD PARTY DEPENDENCIES

The Software may include or depend on open source or third-party software components. These components are subject to their own third-party open source or proprietary license, which User undertakes to comply with.

3. WARRANTY & LIABILITY

AS THE SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE AND SOLELY FOR LIMITED PURPOSES, THE SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED "AS IS" AND B<>COM DISCLAIMS, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, ALL WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, SATISFACTORY QUALITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ACCURACY AND NON-INFRINGEMENT OF THIRD PARTY INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS. THE USER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE EULA IS AGREED AND ACCEPTED AT USER'S OWN RISK WITH REGARDS TO THIRD PARTY INFRINGEMENT ACTIONS.

B<>COM MAY UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGE – DIRECT, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL – CAUSED BY THE SOFTWARE OR USER'S USE OF THE SOFTWARE, EVEN IF B<>COM IS ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGE.

4. DURATION & TERMINATION

The EULA enter into force upon User's download, installation, copy or use of the Software. It remains in force until User has deleted every copy of the Software and the Software's documentation in its possession, or until termination of the EULA, whichever comes first.

User and b<>com each reserve the right to terminate the EULA unilaterally, subject to giving the other a fifteen (15) days written notice.

Furthermore, b<>com may terminate this EULA immediately and without prior notice upon User violation of the license grant limitations of article 1.

At the term or termination of the EULA, User will cease to use the Software and its documentation, and immediately destroy or delete any copy of the Software and documentation in its possession.

All provisions of the EULA which, by their nature, should survive the term or termination will survive it, including, without limitation, the warranty disclaimers and limitations of liability of article 3.

5. MISCELLANEOUS

- > This EULA constitutes the entire agreement between User and b<>com regarding the Software and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings.
- > b<>com retains the right to modify unilaterally the EULA from time to time. Any update of the EULA enters into force thirty (30) days after being notified by email to the User. User's continued use of the Software after an update enters into force constitutes an agreement to this update.
- > b<>com may assign or delegate these Terms in whole or in part, to any person or entity at any time with or without the User's consent.
- > If any provision of this EULA is held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court, the remaining provisions will remain in effect.
- > The fact that b<>com or User does not avail itself of the other's failure to meet its obligations under this EULA cannot be construed as a waiver of the right to invoke any subsequent failure to meet the same obligation or any other obligations, or as a waiver of the right to oversee the application of the said obligations.

6. APPLICABLE LAW & JURISDICTION

This EULA is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of France. Any disputes arising out or in connection with this EULA, including its formation, execution or interpretation, will be brought before the competent courts of Paris (France).
